



CONCERT SERIES POLICIES

The Outlaw Field Concert Series has different policies than other events held at the Idaho Botanical Garden. Please read the following:

You are welcome to bring a picnic under the following guidelines:

- No Alcoholic Beverages: The ONLY beverages allowed must be factory sealed. Canteens/jugs, homemade juices, are not permitted. Unsealed water bottles must be completely empty and can be filled at no cost within the venue.
- You are encouraged to bring your picnic in a bag as opposed to an ice chest. Ice chests are permitted but will require additional search which could delay your entry to the event.
- All shows are general admission and will take place rain or shine. Weather dictating, please bring appropriate rain wear as umbrellas block the view for everyone and are NOT permitted.

Persons with Disabilities - Concerts are presented on a grass park like setting. All guests are either seated on the grass with blankets, or in low back chairs. A limited number of spaces are held in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. We encourage all guests with special needs to contact our office at 208-343-8883 and every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate. As accommodations are limited we can better serve those who assist us with advance coordination.

PERMITTED ITEMS:

- The Botanical Garden is lawn seating; your LOW BACK chairs are welcome (no more than 6 inches off the ground). Tall chairs will not be allowed in the concert venue.
- Blankets (Blanket space will be limited)
- Small picnic basket and/or cooler
- Sealed non-alcoholic beverages

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Outside alcohol
- Umbrellas
- Unsealed beverages/open containers (All non sealed water jugs/containers will be emptied prior to admission)
- Glass containers or bottles (please do not pack picnic items in glass such as salad dressing, sauces, etc)
- Weapons
- Fireworks
- High-back chairs

Please Note: Tickets are required for children over 2 years old for all shows
