Standards and Guidelines

- One application per household. Exhibit is limited to 50 applicants.
- Keep Fairy and Gnome Homes appropriate for a family-friendly environment. Homes that reflect controversial social or political situations will not be accepted.
- Materials must be durable and able to withstand a month of outdoor exposure (snow, rain, hail, wind, sprinklers).
- Home must be built on a firm base with a minimum width of 12"x6" and a maximum of 24"x24".
- Handmade enchanted creatures are welcome to inhabit your home. **All materials must be securely attached.**Use exterior-grade sealant, paint and adhesives.
- To keep our garden healthy and beautiful, please avoid the following materials on your creation: cardboard, hot glue, glitter, living plants or plant material, edible goods.
- Our staff will not be servicing your creations but may notify you if your home needs attention.

The Idaho Botanical Garden reserves the right to remove or refuse any creation that does not meet these standards.
