Facilitated Field Trip Highlights:

Habitat Investigations Field Trip Experience:

- Students will learn about concepts and participate in hands-on activities that relate to Idaho Content Standard: Life Science (2-LS-2.1).

Station 1:

- Students will learn to apply observation skills to identify different plants in the Garden based on their similarities and differences.

Station 2:

- Students will learn how to sort live macroinvertebrates from our pond by observing their body parts.

Station 3:

- Students will learn how to use a tool to identify samples of macroinvertebrates based on similarities and differences in their body parts.
