Facilitated Field Trip experience for Kindergarteners



Facilitated Field Trip Highlights:

- 90-min. outdoor program includes 3 hands-on learning stations.
- Revamped grade-specific STEAM curriculum.
- Experiential learning in a living museum lead by an IBG facilitator.

Sprouts Field Trip Experience:

- Students will learn about concepts and participate in engaging hands-on activities that relate to Idaho Content Standards K-LS1-1.1 and K-ESS-1.2.

Station 1:

- Students will learn about what plants need to live and grow, then use this knowledge to plant their own seeds to take home.

Station 2:

- Students will learn about compost and apply their knowledge of what plants and animals need to live to draw connections.

Station 3:

- Students will learn that plants have different needs depending on where they are and visit a unique part of the Garden to make observations to determine if plant needs are being met.



Idaho Content Standards
