Standards and Guidelines

- Contest is limited to 20 applicants. One application per household.
- Keep gingerbread houses appropriate for a family-friendly environment. Gingerbread houses that reflect controversial social or political situations will not be accepted.
- <u>Do not include baked or edible goods</u>. Materials must be durable and able to withstand a month of outdoor exposure (snow, ice, wind, etc.).
- To keep the Garden healthy and beautiful, please avoid the following materials: cardboard, hot glue, glitter, *living* plants or plant material, baked or edible goods.
- Use exterior-grade sealant, paint, and adhesives.
- Build on a firm base with a minimum width of 12"x6" and a maximum of 24"x24".
- Handouts, promotional materials, free giveaways, and signs for the purpose of advertising are not permitted. Corporate branding, such as a logo or sticker, is allowed.
