Habitat Investigations Field Trip Experience

• Students will learn about science concepts and then participate in hands-on activities that relate to Idaho Content Standard 2-LS-2.1.

Station 1:

 Students will apply observation skills to describe how plants in the Firewise Garden have adaptations to survive in the dry and sunny habitat.

Station 2:

 Students will learn how to sort live macroinvertebrates from our pond by observing and predicting the function of their body parts.

Station 3:

• Students will learn how to use a dichotomous key to identify and compare macroinvertebrates based on similarities and differences in their body parts.
